## Ductal Carcinoma in Situ

### Choosing your treatment

**In ductal carcinoma in situ (DCIS)** cancer cells are found only inside the ducts in the breast that carry milk to the nipple. This is also called noninvasive breast cancer, noninfiltrating breast cancer or Stage 0. The goal of treatment is to help prevent invasive cancer from developing and to lower the chance of DCIS coming back. There are several treatment options and this program will help you decide, together with your doctor, which choice is best for you.
