

SimMan Classic



SimMan is a patient simulation system that facilitates training of Basic and Advanced Life Support. These systems allow the instructor to effectively assess the learner's individual and team skills based on realistic clinical situations.

The manikin allows observation and recognition of most vital signs. This is achieved through direct interaction with the manikin and observation of the manikin's status which can also be viewed on the Patient Monitor PC.

SimMan provides simulation-based education to challenge and test students' clinical and decision-making skills during realistic patient care scenarios. SimMan includes well-proven software and an interactive technologically advanced manikin allowing learners to practice the emergency treatment of patients.

SimMan Classic, launched in 2001, was discontinued in 2011 with the introduction of SimMan Essential. SimMan Classic officially entered retirement on April 29, 2016. The PSTC maintains a limited number of SimMan manikins for airway and IV management scenarios, and because it is easily moulaged and cleaned after training.
